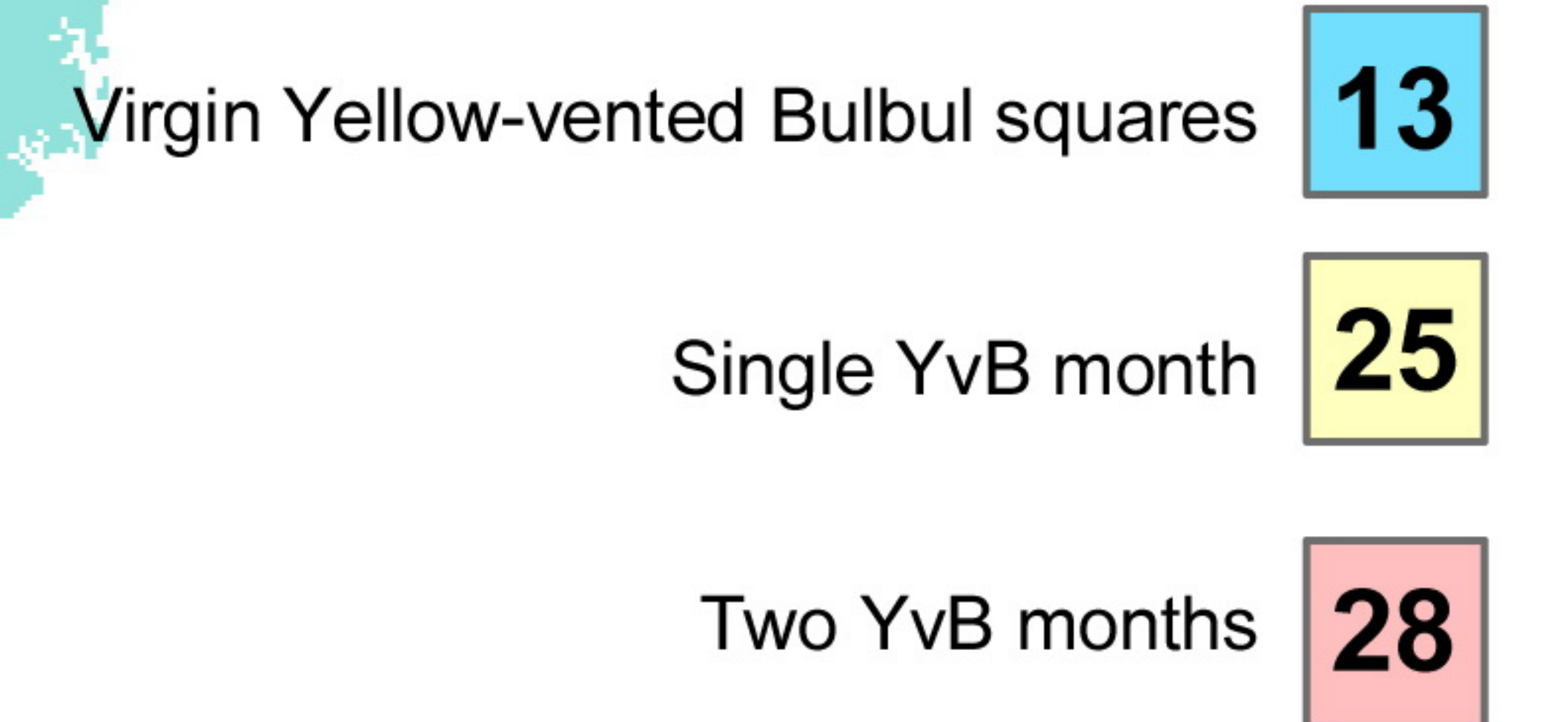


# Lesser Sandplover

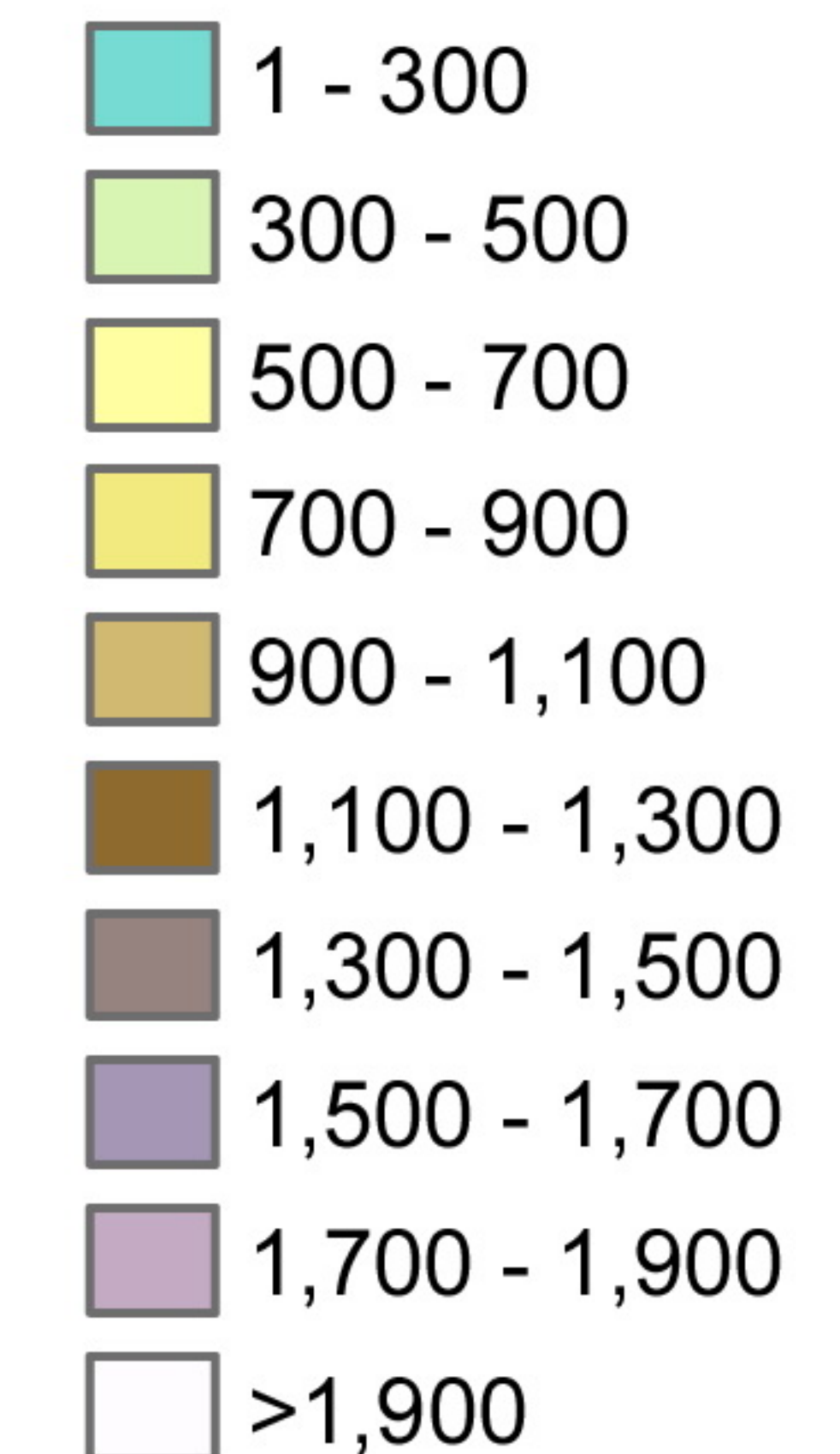

The 1% criteria for this population is now 1,250 birds with no sites yet identified for Tanzania.

It is less common along our coast as a wintering resident than Greater Sandplover. However, large flocks are sometimes seen during return passage and there could be significant feeding sites for these birds.

One to watch out for if you are at the coast in April.

These few inland records are rather typical of several coastal species.
