

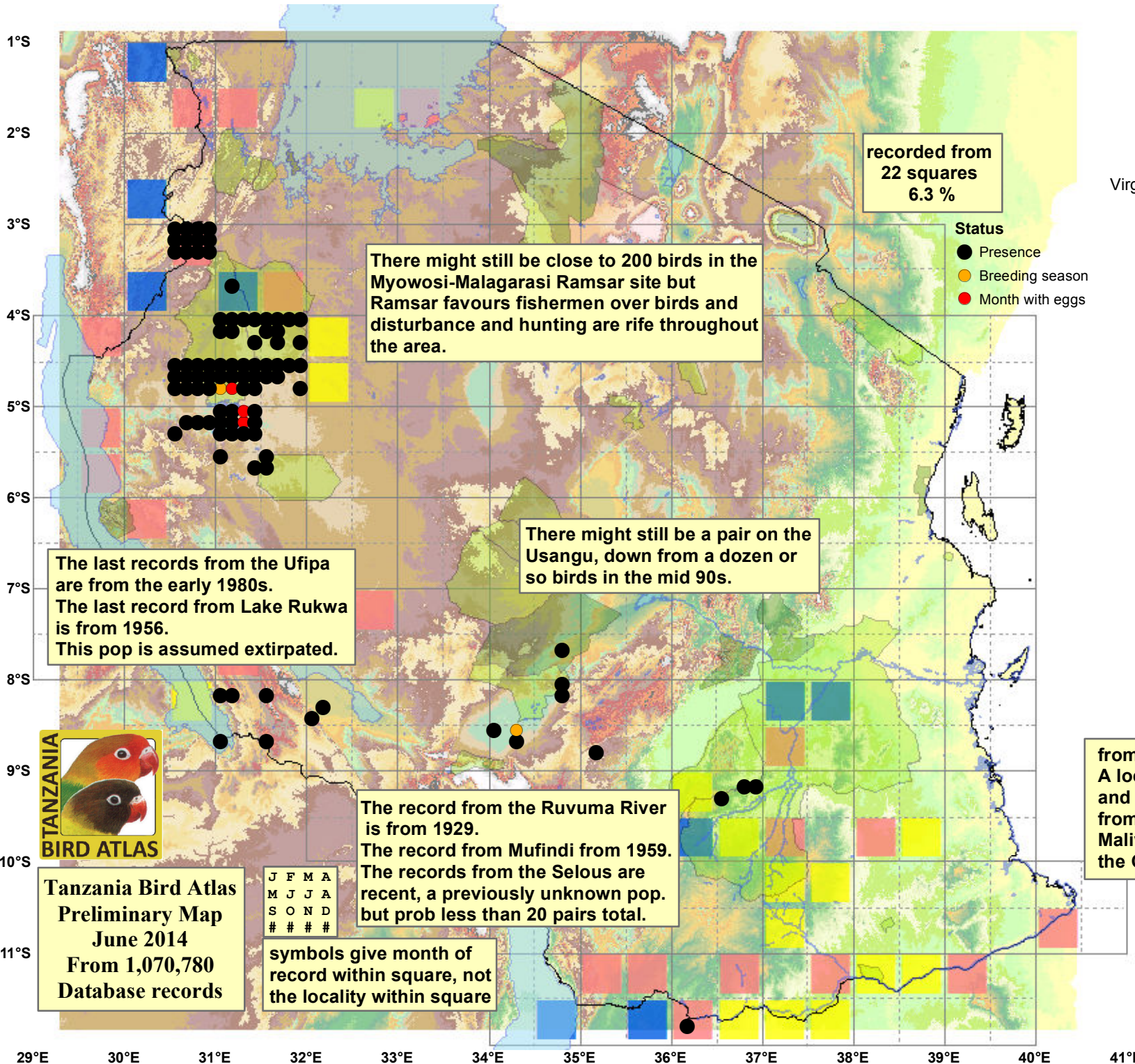

There might still be close to 200 birds in the Myowosi-Malagarasi Ramsar site but Ramsar favours fishermen over birds and disturbance and hunting are rife throughout the area.

There might still be a pair on the Usangu, down from a dozen or so birds in the mid 90s.

The last records from the Ufipa are from the early 1980s. The last record from Lake Rukwa is from 1956. This pop is assumed extirpated.

The record from the Ruvuma River is from 1929. The record from Mufindi from 1959. The records from the Selous are recent, a previously unknown pop. but prob less than 20 pairs total.
